Entry Option 1 SCHOOLS NORTH APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAM (SNAP)

Work experience program for secondary school students (at least 16 years old).

Find an Employer/Sponsor

The employer must be willing to sponsor your apprenticeship and have a licensed journey person to supervise you.

Work in the Trade

Hours applied to regular apprenticeship.

Entry Option 3 TRADES QUALIFIER

Individuals with significant work experience including other provinces or country's) qualified to write a challenge exam.
